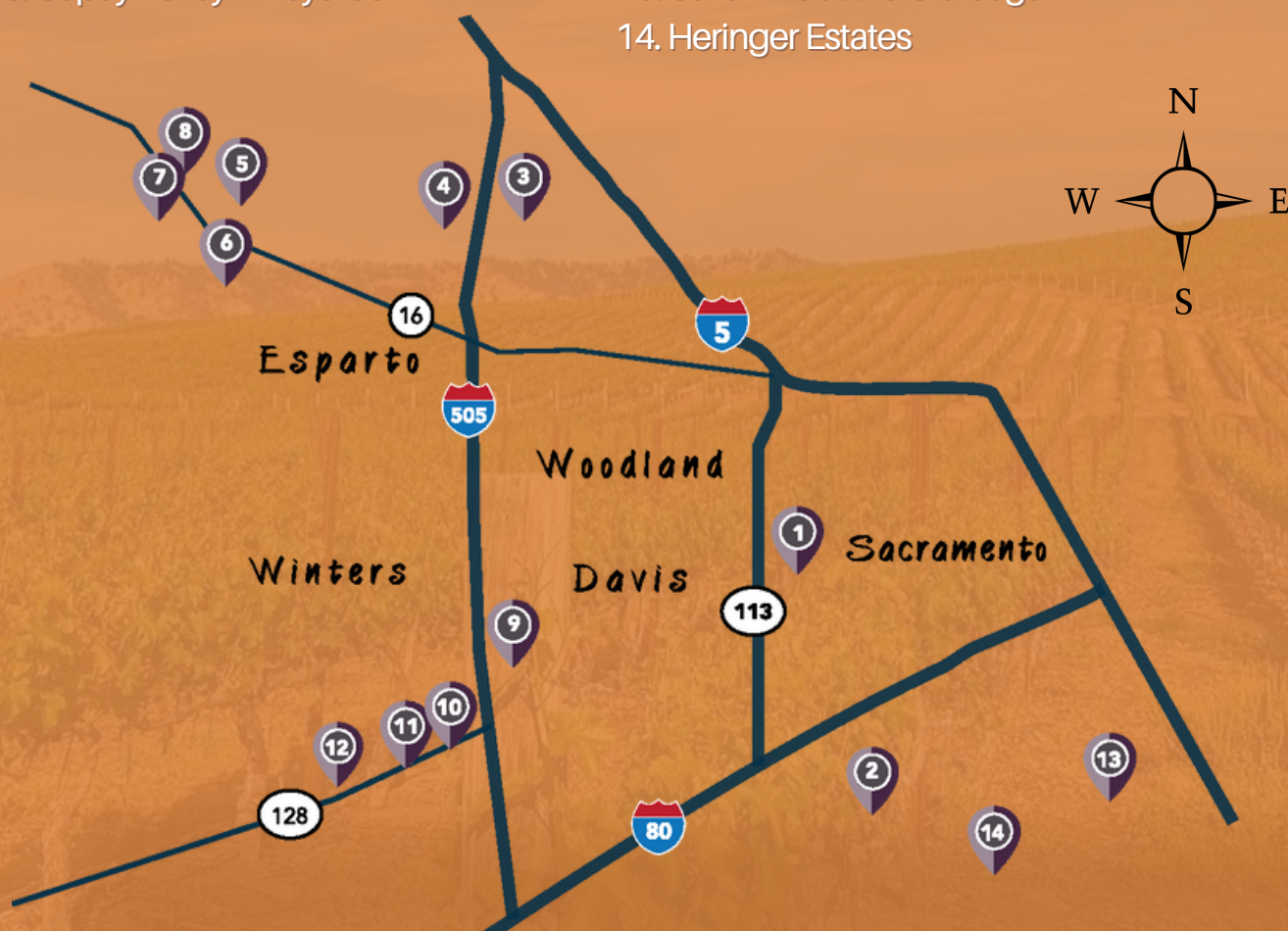

RAMBLE AROUND *Clarksburg*



Tucked in the far southeast corner of Yolo County along the curling river bends of the Sacramento River, lies Clarksburg. By population, you might miss this micro-town on a map. However, the summertime brings with it outstanding daily temperature swings which make this region a winemaking haven. Next time you find yourself in Clarksburg, be sure to ask for a glass of Chenin Blanc or Petite Sirah—they do it best.

ELEVATION TEN

Located in Clarksburg's Old Sugar Mill, this boutique winery is known for their proprietary blends including a red blend and a vin blanc.

HERINGER

The Heringer family has been farming Clarksburg soil since 1868 and planted their first vineyard in the 1970s. Today, the family produces over 30 sustainable wines.

JULIETTA WINERY

Great wine and friendly people is the mantra for this husband and wife-owned winery. Enjoy a flight of wines, by the glass, or one of their signature wine slushies on their expansive patio.

SÉKA HILLS

The sister property to their Capay Valley location, at the Old Sugar Mill guests can see where Séka Hills wines are made.

LOCAL EATS & MUST DO'S

Grab some friends and have some fun on the **Sacramento River Fox Train**, a historic train that travels 28 miles along the picturesque Old Garden Highway, serving wine and beer along your journey!



RAMBLE AROUND

Davis



The home to UC Davis, this eco-friendly college town has deep roots in its veterinary, agriculture, and you guessed it, viticulture programs. The flat topography and fertile Yolo County soil make this region a farmers' paradise.

Agriculture is rich in these parts, and you can't venture far without seeing vibrant fields of gold—whether they be wheat, corn, or endless rows of shining sunflowers.

GREAT BEAR VINEYARDS

This family-run and operated winery is located just 2 miles from the heart of downtown Davis. The family proudly tends to their vines by hand year-round, producing award-winning sustainable wines from their little "slice of heaven in Yolo County". In addition to your glass of wine, you can also enjoy estate grown olive oil and lavender products.

LOCAL EATS & MUST DO'S

Taste local produce and other products at one of Davis' many **farmer's markets**.

Catch a show at the **Mondavi Center for the Performing Arts**.



RAMBLE AROUND *Winters*

Venture about 30 miles west of Sacramento, and you'll stumble upon a quaint, farm-to-fork community with a palate that shoots for the stars. This tight-knit farming community has been building their rapport for great food and great wine in recent years—and they're getting noticed. Visitors flock from nearby regions to relax in the small-town charm and enjoy the local eats, drinks and shopping.

TURKOVICH FAMILY WINES

Producing small-lot wines from vineyards in Western Yolo County, this family-owned and operated winery specializes in Syrah, Viognier, Tempranillo, and Petite Sirah. Enjoy a tasting paired with local cheeses at their downtown tasting room, or plan your trip around an event at their working winery surrounded by stunning 360-degree views of the Yolo County countryside and Vaca Mountain range.

BERRYESSA GAP VINEYARDS

With a history rooted deep in Yolo County farming, the Martinez family developed a grapevine rootstock nursery in 1969 which helped foster the Napa, Sonoma, and Yolo winemaking regions that we know today. Now, you can enjoy the family's wines under the Berryessa Gap label at their downtown Winters tasting room or at their estate winery located on Highway 128.

LOCAL EATS & MUST DO'S

Check out a local **event!** The Earthquake Festival, Lighted Tractor Parade, and various street festivals with live music make Winters a year-round, family-friendly destination.

Spend the night and enjoy the rooftop bar at **Hotel Winters**, the boutique hotel and spa.

Sip on a craft beer at **Berryessa Brewing Co.** while enjoying the relaxed, family-friendly atmosphere in a country setting.



RAMBLE AROUND

Dunnigan Hills

The views of the rolling Dunnigan Hills are a must-see for your next visit to Yolo County. Just off the 505, and about 40 miles northwest of Sacramento, you'll begin to think you've been transported to a new place. The city melts away as shades of green and gold fill every corner. Roll your windows down and enjoy the Delta breeze, and soak up the sunshine—spectacular Chardonnay, Syrah, and Tempranillo are headed your way.

GRINDSTONE WINERY

With a strong belief in "farm-to-glass" farming practices, this family puts sustainability first. From improving soil health to protecting wildlife, the family-owned and operated winery is always making strides to help the environment that gives back to them (and produces their fantastic wines!). Enjoy a tasting in their modern farmhouse or in their grassy park all while enjoying peaceful views of the coast range.

MATCHBOOK WINE COMPANY

This family-owned winery is tucked away in the rolling Dunnigan Hills. Their tasting room is a destination for wine lovers looking to discover quality estate-grown varietals and spectacular views.

LOCAL EATS & MUST DO'S

Plan your visit during the Dunnigan Hills Road Race and get inspired to **ride your bike** through the rolling hills.

Grab a local **picnic lunch** to enjoy at Grindstone or Matchbook while overlooking the Pacific Coast Range. If you're lucky enough to visit in the summertime, you might be able to **catch some live music** at either winery!



RAMBLE AROUND *Capay Valley*

A trip to the far northwest corner of Yolo County will not disappoint. This serene stretch of fertile land dances in the colors of the season—any time of year you'll be treated to a show of natural wonder. Take a tour of a working farm, enjoy a farm-to-fork dinner, take a hike in the hills, or catch a show at the Cache Creek Casino. The possibilities are endless and the hospitality is always ready to welcome you.

SÉKA HILLS

Honoring the native Patwin language and the Native American roots of which the winery was founded, the name "Séka" means blue and is a nod to the blue hills that watch over the winery. Located directly across the street from the Cache Creek Resort and Casino, here you can taste the wines, olive oils, and other specialty foods from the Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation.

TABER RANCH VINEYARD & EVENT CENTER

This multi-faceted Capay Valley destination is the perfect place to spend a Saturday enjoying a glass of wine, listening to a live band, and a fresh pizza straight out of the pizza oven. If you're planning something bigger than that, say a wedding, family gathering, or celebration of any kind, they've got you covered there too.

CAPAY VALLEY VINEYARDS

This husband and wife duo are long-time residents of the Capay Valley and have been making wine since 1998. They proudly grow, harvest, and produce all of their own wines—including their signature sparkling wines!

SIMAS FAMILY WINES

This small family-owned winery specialized in estate-grown Rhône varietals and a tasting room coming soon!
